

# UNIQUE PHOTOGRAPHIC OPPORTUNITY



Towering some 40 metres over the historic City of Lichfield the Spire Viewing Platform at Lichfield Heritage Centre provides a photographer's dream opportunity. Having reached the top the reward is outstanding views over the mediaeval Cathedral with its 3 spires, the ancient City, and the surrounding countryside.

Weather permitting the Spire is open most weekends and some week days, 10am - 4pm (5pm Saturday- last climb 1 hour prior to closing). The climb to the viewing platform involves the ascent of 144 steps by a series of staircases/ladders some of which are quite steep. All visitors are accompanied by one of our volunteer spire guides and it is therefore essential, to avoid disappointment, that visitors contact us prior to their visit and we will arrange for a guide to be available. We ask that visitors be in good health and that sensible footwear and clothing is worn. Unfortunately, for insurance reasons, we cannot allow children under the age of 10 to make the climb.

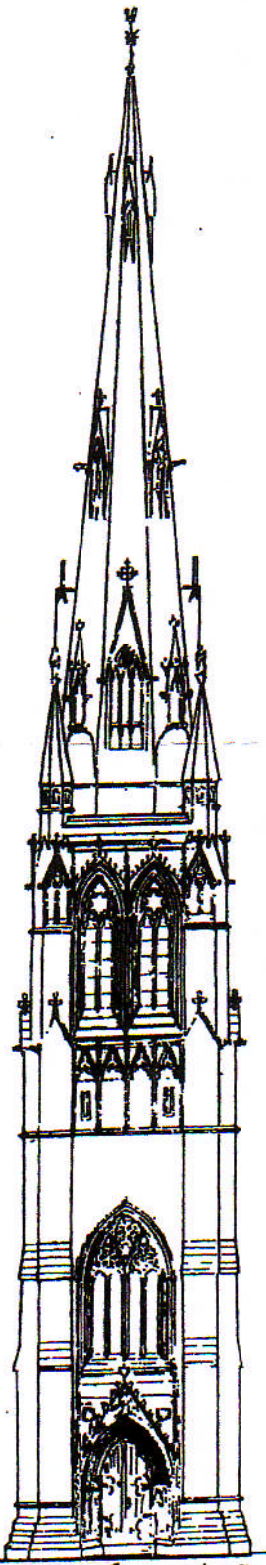
Whilst visiting the Heritage Centre you may also wish to view the Lichfield Story Exhibition, which tells the story of Lichfield's rich and varied history from the Celts through to the present day. The Exhibition is also home to the unique Staffordshire Millennium Embroideries and a Treasury of fine Civic, Regimental and Church Silver. Light refreshments and lunches are available in the ground floor Coffee Shop.

The Heritage Centre is a financially independent organisation and we do therefore make a modest admission charge. For those only wishing to climb the Spire the charge is £2.50 for adults and £1.00 for children. The adult charge for the Exhibition is £3.50 and again lower concessionary rates apply for other age groups.
